ABOUT US

The Dawn School is recognized and affiliated to the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur. The Junior School at Lailam Veng has classes from Preparatory to Class III, the Administrative Office including the Fee Counter is also located here. The Senior School at Ephraim Hill, Thingkangphai has classes from IV to X.

In The Dawn School, we believe that the quest for knowledge should be governed by the fear of our Creator, thus our School motto says, **“The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom...” (Prov. 9:10)**. While keeping in mind our main role of providing education to our children, we are committed to instil in them the fear of God as the motivating factor in making life’s decision.

OUR VISION & AIM

Empowered and responsible generations of youth - physically, mentally and spiritually equipped, making a difference in the lives of others.

We aim:

- ▶ To create a happy family school with an open channel of communication between children, teachers and parents.
- ▶ To instil in each child the importance of the fear of the Lord as the key to gain wisdom.
- ▶ To facilitate the learning process of each child in an environment of mutual love, trust and respect
- ▶ To draw out the potential of each child and bring it to blossom through various activities
- ▶ To equip each child with the knowledge and skills needed to face the challenges of life.

At the Dawn School, we recognized and respect the value and uniqueness of each child and treat them accordingly. We therefore strive each day to draw out these special skills and encourage the children to blossom to their full potential and be an asset to the society. As facilitators of learning we have adopted the following theme as our guiding principle.

Theme: 3 A's

- Aspire** : We encourage our children to dream, realistic dreams.
- Achieve** : We empower them to achieve their dreams.
- Ascend** : We inspire them to climb even higher and go on beyond their dreams.

A. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. School Timing:

2. Any change regarding the above given timing will be notified. Parents are to ensure that their wards are on time.
3. School holidays will be observed with prior notification. In case of any unscheduled holiday, confirmation can be made by checking the notice board at the gate.
4. Changes in residence and contact numbers should be communicated in writing to the office immediately when they occur.
5. The school does not hold itself responsible for injuries sustained while in school, however first aid will be rendered immediately and those necessitating Hospital / OPD treatment attended to without delay.
6. Collection of funds for whatever use is forbidden without prior permission of the Headmistress. Students shall not sell or take orders for anything in the school or in the name of the school.
7. Parents and students are forbidden to give gifts to teachers. A token gift of a flower or sweet may be allowed on special occasions.
8. Students are to behave politely at all times and avoid use of indecent language or actions to hurt other students, teachers or staff of the school. Any such behaviour will attract serious disciplinary action.
9. Students are responsible for their conduct not only in the school but outside as well. It is expected that through their

good behaviour they enhance the prestige of the school. Any report of misbehaviour or objectionable conduct will be liable for disciplinary action.

10. Parents and Students are requested to be mindful of their comments & languages or materials posted in all forms of Social Media. The School will take serious note of any derogatory or disparaging remarks and may be forced to resort to legal recourse.

B. SCHOOL DIARY:

1. The School Diary is compulsory for every student and must be brought to school every day.
2. Personal details like name, class, roll no. etc should be filled in legible handwritings.
3. Parents/ Guardians are to sign in the space provided for Parents signature.
4. Parents/ Guardians are expected to check their ward's diary every day and sign against the homework, activities and notice given to their wards by the teachers. The school diary is to be preserved carefully; no pages should be destroyed, torn or smudged.
5. Negligence in making regular entry into the diary is an offense liable for disciplinary action.
6. The school diary if lost will be replaced on payment. However, a student will not be allowed to replace it more than once in an academic year.

C. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. Students are to converse only in English.
2. Students should strictly adhere to the school timing.
3. Students are to come to the school in complete school uniform.

4. Eatables, toys and money should not be brought to the school, exceptional cases should be reported and submitted to the Class Teacher.
5. Cell phones are not allowed in the school – if found in the possession of any student, will be confiscated and will not be returned till the academic year gets over. The school will not be responsible in case of lost or damaged while in its care.
6. Pencils, rulers, pens etc. recommended by the school only is to be used.
7. Impersonating of Parents over the phone or forging of parent's signature is a serious offense and will be dealt with accordingly.
8. **Personal Appearance, Habits & Hygiene:**
 - a. Regular hair trimming is required for boys and girls with short hair.
 - b. Girls with long hair are to tie their hair with red ribbons or red hair bands.
 - c. No fancy earring, bangles, finger rings, hair clips, spectacle frames and wrist watches are to be worn.
 - d. Carrying cosmetics or applying them, excluding moisturisers and lip gloss is prohibited.
 - e. Eating or bringing any tobacco product is strictly prohibited.
9. **Attendance:**
 - a. Attendance on the first day of the academic year is compulsory.
 - b. Regular attendance is of utmost importance. However, if a student is absent, a written statement, signed by the Parent/Guardian is required on the day the pupil returns. If a student is absent for more than 3 days for reasons of ill health a certificate from a Doctor

is required stating illness and fitness. If a student is continuously absent for a period more than 30 days. His or her name will be taken off the school record.

- c. Any child afflicted by infectious disease must complete the quarantine period before re-joining class.
- d. Explanatory note for absence should be handed to the class teacher after being forwarded by the Headmistress.
- e. Students absent for more than 20% of class meetings in a year shall not be eligible for promotion to the next class.
- f. Punctuality is highly encouraged, a student found to be habitually late will be sent home and will be considered absent for the day.

10. Home Assignment:

- a. Home Assignments and Projects are to be completed within the stipulated time.
- b. Parents are to go through their child's work book and entries made in the diaries daily, ensure their completion and sign accordingly.
- c. Any queries regarding work assignments should be made to the subject teacher concerned by meeting them in person or by calling them at a good time.

11. Performance Assessment:

There will be Four Terminal Assessment for Classes VI – X, class V & below will have only Two Assessment – Mid-Term Assessment & Final Assessment. The average of all these assessments will be the criteria for promotion or rank to the next class.

- a. Cheating in any form – copying, prompting, showing the answer paper etc. will not be tolerated and severely dealt with.

- b. Children are to bring their own pen, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, colours etc. and not borrow from others.
- c. Complete silence is to be maintained inside the examination hall, queries or doubts are to be clarified with the teacher on duty.

Promotions are based on the whole year's performance. Regularity in work and attendance are of utmost importance. Apart from the Terminal Assessment, the School also regularly assess the daily performance or non-performance of the students. Monthly Star and X Charts are maintained to record the classroom performance, completion of assignments and behaviour of each student.. The Student with the maximum stars is awarded a Certificate of Merit. Besides, 20marks from each subject is also set aside during the terminal assessment as internal marks. The subject teacher has the discretionary power to allot the marks based on the student's handwriting, presentation of answer sheets, general behaviour, personal habits and hygiene. It may also be noted here that if a student displays attitudes and behaviour deemed unbecoming and of ill repute in and outside the school, he or she will not be awarded any internal marks.

A student who has already repeated a class twice and has not shown any improvement will not be allowed to continue in the same class in the next academic session.

D. CO- CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

In order to draw out the innate talents of the children and provide them with organised recreational activities, the children are divided into four houses from Class IV onwards. The names of the houses – Amber, Emerald, Ruby & Sapphire; symbolized to show how precious our children are. Inter

house competitions are organized for various activities like singing, dancing, extempore speech, debates etc, along with other games and sports activities which finally culminates with the Annual Games & Sports. Awards & Certificates are distributed as a part of the Children's Day Celebration/School Festival every year.

E. UNIFORM

The uniform is the identity of the school and each student wearing it should treat their uniform with respect. Altering the shape & design of the uniform is prohibited. No student should behave in a manner that can bring discredit to the wearer or to the school. Every student must wear the prescribed uniform and strictly adhere to the following specification.

F. FEES:

1. Parents are requested to be prompt in payment of fees
2. The school fees are payable in advance or should be paid latest by the 20th of every month. A late fee of Rs. 5/- per day will be levied for late payment.
3. Fees are subject to revision at the discretion of the management.
4. Fees once paid are not refundable.
5. Provision to make payments of the school fees for the whole year in the first 2 months is available.

6. No student will be allowed to sit for any examination unless all dues are cleared.
7. The cash counter is opened from 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM on all working days. Fees and any other payments may be made during this time.
8. Fee payments can be made by cheque in two instalments for the entire academic year.
9. The cheque should be drawn in favour of 'Dawn School'
10. A cheque, if bounced will attract a penalty of Rs. 500.

G. SCHOOL PROPERTY

The students should take care of the school property. Intentional or neglectful damage is a serious offence; appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against the offender. Any accidental damage should be reported immediately to the school authorities.

H. MEETING (Parents – Teachers Meet):

1. Parents are advised to meet their child's teachers at least once a month by making proper appointment after school hours so as to discuss their child's progress or regress if any.
2. Parents/ Guardians are not allowed to meet the teachers during school hours. Those who wish to do so may kindly obtain permission from the Headmistress.
3. Periodic meetings between the parents and teachers will be arranged in order to ensure better understanding and co-ordination in the educational development of the children.
4. Notification regarding this will be given well ahead of time so that Parents are able to make themselves free for the meeting.

5. Parents who fail to attend these meetings will be considered uninterested in their child’s education, repeated failure to attend may eventually force the school authorities to take actions which they deemed fit.

I. WITHDRAWAL

Any parent who wishes to withdraw their child can do so by applying for a Transfer Certificate and clearing all outstanding dues. Once withdrawn, the school is not obligated to re-admit any child.

Complains and queries, if any, should be made to the Headmistress only and to no other member of the staff.
